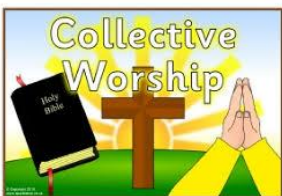
Keystage 2 Movie Night – Friday 23rd March
