#### Nursery

#### Willow

This week we have read The Three Little Pigs. We have re-told the story, made posters and have written some questions to put to the pigs. In Maths we have been finding halves and quarters.

#### Silver Birch

This week we have been using The Three Little Pigs as our stimulus in English. We have sequenced the story, written a wanted poster and produced a newspaper report. In Maths the Year 1 children have been finding halves and quarters while the Year 2 children have been measuring and comparing the length of different objects. We have done some races in the afternoon followed by yoga to relax at the end of the school day.

#### Maple

We have been learning all about the properties of shape through art this week. We have learned about the difference between geometric and biomorphic shapes. In Topic we are constructing our own solar systems and they are starting to look really great.

#### Oak

This week we have been multiplying and dividing fractions in Maths. We have researched different styles of music through the twentieth century and have done some great pop art in the style of Andy Warhol's Campbells soup cans. We have had a go at digital photography too – the week has flown by.
