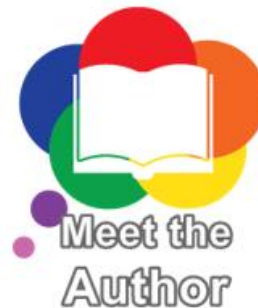


Serial Mash is an online library of fiction books.

There are stories about almost everything – from pirates and football to magical creatures and children who gain strange powers.

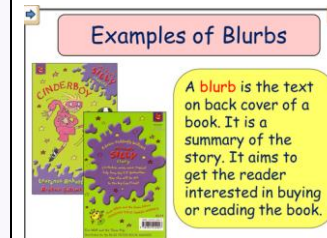
And each book has quizzes and activities to explore, too. Start your first chapter now and begin an adventure.

Write a paragraph about you as the author. This can be the first page of your book.

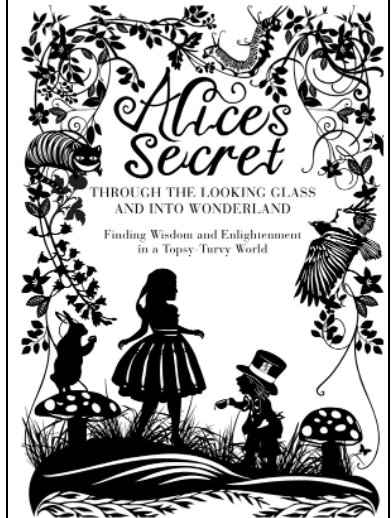
Design an engaging back cover. Write a blurb. What is your story about?
