#### Nursery

We have been doing letter sounds this week, sounding out our names and writing them. We have been reading lots of stories this week – the children especially liked 'Aaargghhh Spider!' - a story about a spider who wants to be the family pet!

#### Willow

This week we have been looking at shape and patterns in Maths. We have read The Gingerbread Man in English and thought about how the lady who baked the gingerbread man felt when he ran away! We also did a fun science experiment with gingerbread men made from toast to see if they could swim!

#### Silver Birch

We have been writing our own versions of the Gingerbread Man story. In Maths we have been doing multiplication and division and the Year 1 children have been looking at the property of shapes. In the afternoons we have been learning about the UK, colouring the flags of the four countries. We made famous London landmarks, learned about the Giant's Causeway and Mrs Cruse taught us some Welsh words too!

#### Chestnut

This week we have been busy learning how to use a protractor correctly to find missing angles on a straight line. In English we have been writing newspaper reports and keeping up to date with Newsround. We also made hedgehog books and studied and sketched wild flowers.

#### Maple

In Maple Class this week we have been writing non-chronological reports on a subject of our choice. These have ranged from the Airbus 380 to Penguins! We are enjoying reading Kensuke's Kingdom and have started to create caves. Kensuke lived in a very organised cave, so we are zoning his open plan living! In Maths the Year 4s have been counting and ordering money and the Year 5s have continued work on decimals, this time subtracting, using the column method.



## SOME OF THE HOME LEARNING THAT WE HAVE RECEIVED THIS WEEK
